





THIS IS A PROPERTY TAX INCREASE.



Phase 3 of Multi-Purpose Athletic Complexes

- 50-Yard Indoor Practice Field (with one end zone) at All High Schools
- Can be scheduled by student programs on a regular basis and as a safe alternative during inclement weather.



- Bond Refundings since 2010 have saved \$150,999,094.
- Redemptions/Defeasances (pay down debt earlier) have reduced debt by an additional \$38,967,538.

Maintenance & Operations (M&O)

Day-to-day operations and expenses for:

- Salaries
- **Utilities**
- Supplies Repairs Fuel

Impacted by State



Interest & Sinking (I&S)

Principal and interest payments on debt issued for:

- New construction
- Renovations
- **HVAC Systems**
- Roofing
- Technology
- Buses
- Land

Impacted by MISD



MISD Debt Services Tax Rate

When we are talking about **bonds**, we are only talking about the debt service, or the I&S tax rate.





The I&S tax rate will not increase as a result of the 2024 bond election.

MISD M&O Tax Rate - Penny Swap

In 2021, MISD voters approved a VATRE to increase the district's M&O tax rate by 13 cents, generating additional funding for teacher salaries, student programs, instruction, and district operations.






Tax Rate History



The total tax rate is 31¢ lower than it was four years ago.

Bonding Capacity



Tax Ceiling for Homeowners 65+

The dollar amount of **MISD taxes** for a person 65 years of age or older **cannot be increased** above the amount paid in the first year after the person turned 65 – regardless of changes in tax rate or property value – unless significant improvements are made to the home.
